Halam Church of England Primary is a unique place. It is a happy, caring and high-achieving church school with an individual identity that combines a vibrant vision with traditional values. Its peaceful village setting and long history evoke a sense of community, at the same time, housing a forward thinking and dynamic learning environment.

The school is set in the heart of Halam village and is only a couple of minutes drive from Southwell town centre. We welcome applications for places from outside of our catchment area and already have a number of children from other locations.

We are fully committed to the development of your child in partnership with you. We aim to offer your child an education that is filled with opportunities and experiences that instill a lifelong love of learning. We want each child to be a self-confident, enquiring, creative learner who is able to solve problems, communicate effectively and relate well to others.

The school is organised into four classrooms: Lower Primary 1 accommodates Reception and Year 1 children; Lower Primary 2 takes Year 1 and Year 2; Middle Primary consists of Years 3 and 4, and Upper Primary houses Years 5 to 6. The total number of children on roll for the year beginning September 2009 was 105. The school's capacity is 120.

We promote Christian values and this is reflected in the exemplary behaviour and kind, caring attitudes of our children. We have strong links with the churches of St Giles, Edingley and St Michaels in Halam. Assemblies are held regularly by the priest in charge of our local churches.

Our well proportioned red brick building is surrounded by extensive play areas, an adventure



playground, a sports field, vegetable plots, well stocked gardens and a newly planted wildflower area. The school has a large hall, a dining area and very modern IT facilities. We also have a new and very popular secure outdoor play facility for our youngest pupils.

We offer a wide range of extra curricular clubs and activities and also have an after school club which runs until 6.00pm.
